Town of Arcadia Minutes of Regular Board Meeting Tuesday, October 9, 2012 at 7 p.m.

The October 9, 2012 board meeting was called to order by Chairman Ronald Tuschner at 7:00 p.m. Open meeting certifications were met. Roll call was taken. All Board members were present: Chairman Ronald Tuschner and Supervisors Michael Wineski and Ivan Pronschinske. Also present were the attached list of residents.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to adopt the agenda as prepared. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the September 24, 2012 meeting minutes. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve disbursements of October 9, 2012 voucher #17220 through voucher #17271. R. Tuschner requested that a copy of check #17264 regarding Amundson Lane into the Amundson Lane project file folder. The Town of Arcadia is to be reimbursed 50% of that invoice from Trempealeau County. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

At 7:04 p.m. R. Tuschner opened the floor to public comments for other topics that were not listed on the October 9, 2012 agenda. R. Tuschner made a second call for requests for comments.

R. Tuschner made a third call for requests for comments. No public comments were made.

At 7:04 p.m. R. Tuschner closed the floor to public comments.

Alpine Sand LLC, and Hector Casillas of TPS regarding Soppa Road.

Mr. Casillas updated the Board of Supervisors that Soppa road has been shouldered to create a longer life on the road. The Board discussed with Alpine Sand LLC that they would like them to be on the same road use agreement as the other non-metallic sand mines. The shoulder will be graveled in order to keep compacting the shoulder. After the frost in 2013, Alpine will inspect the road and will repair where it necessary. Further discussion occurred between Mr. Casillas and the Board of Supervisors regarding the maintenance and reimbursement of funds to maintain the road.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve a temporary road use agreement for TPS. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Conditional Use Permit for KAW non metallic sand mine

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by R. Tuschner to bring this topic off the table. I. Pronschinske stated he would abstain from any comments on item B. The motion was carried with a voice vote. This topic is now on the table.

M. Wineski stated he did not have any further conditions for KAW non metallic sand mine. A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by R. Tuschner to approve the conditions for KAW non metallic sand mine and send a letter to Trempealeau County that the Town of Arcadia Board of Supervisors does not have any opposition to the KAW non metallic sand mine conditional use permit. Further discussion occurred.

At 7:30 p.m. R. Tuschner opened the floor to public comments for other topics. A request from the floor was made by a resident to read the conditions for KAW non metallic sand mine.

R. Tuschner read each condition aloud.

A concern was stated by a resident of the Town of Arcadia regarding the back up alarms on rented equipment. R. Tuschner advised that the conditional use states that back up alarms must be used on all equipment. An additional concern arose regarding the use of strobe lights on the equipment. A discussion occurred regarding the use of strobe lights on equipment. Further investigation on this issue will be done by KAW non metallic sand mine.

R. Tuschner read a letter received from Brent Pickard of Divisions of Transportation Systems Development office in Eau Claire regarding the proposal by KAW Valley Companies for a facility in Trempealeau County. The letter will be put into the town file for Alpine Sand Mine.

A letter addressed to Alpine Sand Mine, Hector Casillas from Mr. Paul Winey was received by R. Tuschner and put into the town file for Alpine Sand non metallic sand mine.

R. Tuschner made a second call for requests for comments. R. Tuschner made a third call for requests for comments. No public comments were made. At 7:50 p.m. R. Tuschner closed the floor to public comments.

The motion was carried with a voice vote.

Operator's License for Rebecca Krause

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the Operator's License for Rebecca Krause. A background check was done and was found satisfactorily. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

"Class A Liquor License

The application for a "Class A" Liquor license was received from Christine M. Derrickson and Roger A. Derrickson, owners of North O Town/Briar Patch, Inc. to only sell wine at their business.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve the Class A Liquor license for North O Town/Briar Patch, Inc. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

Set date in November for Proposed Budget Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting.

A motion was made by R. Tusher and seconded by M. Wineski to have the meeting for the Proposed Budget Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting on Thursday, November 8 at 7 p.m.

The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to set a working budget meeting on Tuesday, October 30, 2012 at 7:00 p.m.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to set the next regular Town of Arcadia meeting to Monday, October 29, 2012 at 7 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
