## Town of Arcadia Minutes of Regular Board Meeting Monday, July 30, 2012

The 2012, board meeting was called to order by Chairman Ronald Tuschner at 7 p.m.

Open meeting certifications were met. Roll call was taken. All Board members were present: Chairman Ronald Tuschner and Supervisors Michael Wineski and Ivan Pronschinske, and the attached list of residents.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to adopt the agenda as prepared. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve the minutes of April 12, 2012 meeting. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the minutes of May 14, 2012 meeting. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve the minutes of July 9, 2012 meeting. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion made by M. Wineski and seconded by R. Tuschner to approve disbursements of July 30, 2012 from voucher #17109 through voucher # 17128. R. Tuschner made a comment that check number 17113 dated 7/30/2012 in the amount of \$85.00 requested that the Treasurer, Nancy Rohn, be advised that this bill must be invoice to Alpine Sands, LLC. for legal services for the irrevocable letter of credit. The legal services need to billed to Alpine Sands, LLC for reimbursements to the Town of Arcadia. The motion was carried with a voice vote

At 7:03 p.m. R. Tuschner opened the floor to public comments for other topics that were not listed on the July 30, 2012 agenda. R. Tuschner made a second call for requests for comments. R. Tuschner made a third call for requests for comments. No further public comments were made. At 7:04 p.m. R. Tuschner closed the floor to public comments.

### **A possible resolution joint with the City of Arcadia pertaining to the Highway 95/93 intersection for constituents' safety.**

Robert Wozney, who is a member of the Highway Safety Committee, spoke to the Board of Supervisors about the Highway 95/93 intersection. Discussion occurred regarding a concern if there would be a turn about on Highway 93 and Highway 95. A discussion occurred in regards to a lack of emergency run off on Highway 93. R. Wozney stated that if there were any further concerns that they could be forwarded to R. Wozney he would take the concern to the next Highway Safety Meeting to be held in October.

### **Cemetery directory Project presented by Conner Misch.**

Conner Misch, who is a Boy Scout in Troop 64, is working on his Eagle Merit Badge Project. He made a formal presentation to the Board that he would like to put a 4 ft x 8 ft directory inside the Arcadia Public Cemetery. The sign would also consist of a list of War Veteran's and history of Arcadia. The funds for the project would be provided by the funds raised Conner Misch. There would be no cost to the Town of Arcadia of Arcadia.

A motion was made R. Tuschner and seconded by M. Wineski that the Town of Arcadia Board of Supervisors grant Conner Misch the permission for the cemetery directory project with a minimum of 50% estimated costs of the project be born by the Town of Arcadia Cemetery Fund. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

### **Policies for Public Cemeteries**

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to table the topic of policies for public cemeteries for a later date. The motion was made with a voice vote.

### **Schneider non-metallic sand mine presented by Wisconsin Land.**

A formal presentation was made by Dave McDaniel, Project Manager of Auth. Consulting/Associates, and also Roy Burlingame, Broker, of Buy Wisconsin Land for the Schneider non-metallic sand mine.

The mine site consists of two 40 acres parcels to the north and three 77 acre parcels. The access will be off of Highway 95. There will not be a high capacity well. Discussion occurred on the ground water, entrances to the mine site.

Chairman, R. Tuschner requested that the Town of Arcadia be copied on all correspondence from the Department of Transportation on this project.

At 7:49 p.m. opened the floor to public comments or concerns. R. Tuschner made a second call for requests for comments. R. Tuschner made a third call for requests for comments. No public further comments were made. At 7:49 p.m. R. Tuschner closed the floor to public comments.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to issue a letter to the Trempealeau County Department of Land Management stating the Town Board did not have any objections to the opening Schneider non-metallic sand mine as all requirements and safety concerns were met. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

The Conditions for the Schneider non-metallic sand mine were added as an agenda item for the next Board meeting.

### **Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) – Mahutga Lane**

The only bid received for the Mahutga Lane Project is from Arcadia Sands, LLC in the amount of \$10,414.00. A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to accept the bid from Arcadia Sands, LLC for the Mahutga Lane project.

Further discussion occurred on the fill for the project. R. Tuschner stated that he has a sand pit and stated he would donate the sand for the project. R. Tuschner requested that if a permit is required that he not have to incur the cost of the permit. The road will have crush rock over the winter and will not be paved until next year. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

### **Korpall Valley Road over Trempealeau River – Ayers and Associates**

A discussion occurred on the size of the culvert for the Korpall Valley Road. The project will begin roughly around the middle of August. A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske that Arcadia Sands, LLC. execute the construction work on Korpall Valley Road as soon as the culvert is available. Further discussion occurred. The motion was carried by a voice vote.

### **A request from Gold'n Plump Company for a road permit of 90,000 pounds.**

M. Wineski explained to the other Board members that there was a law change in which in you have add an axle to a truck you load at 90,000 pounds where currently maximum load is 80,000 pounds. For Gold'n Plump to be able to use the new law, they require permission from the local governing body who is in charge of the roads and the bridges that they travel. Gold'n Plump is requesting approval to travel on roads and bridges and they also need to know all exceptions. .

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the request by Gold'n Plump for the WI s.348.27(18) "Farm and Field" permit pending the list of bridges that may not be suitable for the weight limit 90,000 pounds. Further discussion occurred. A suggestion was made that Ayers and Associates provide the Town of Arcadia with a list of all Town of Arcadia bridges and the weight capacity of each bridge. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

**Purchase of trailer from Larry Sopopa**

R. Tuschner requested that this topic be tabled at this time and be added to an agenda a later date.

**Operators License for Brandon Suchla.**

A correction was made to the Board by Town Clerk that the Operator's License is for Brandon Sonsalla. The wrong last name was typed on the agenda. A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the Operator's License for Brandon Sonsalla. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

**Update by Town of Arcadia Foreman on Town of Arcadia projects, maintenance and equipment**

Amundson Lane by pass project will begin on Wednesday morning.

A discussion occurred on part time help for the winter snow plow season. The Board recommended that the Town clerk place an advertisement for part time employment will be placed in the local newspaper.

Brush cutting will continue until the Fall. Discussion occurred cutting on the over growth of tree branches and proper equipment required by OSHA to cut the tree branches.

Estimate received from Simmons Roofing, LLC for repair of damage to the shop roof from the hail storm in May.

**Agenda items were discussed**

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded to set the next regular Town of Arcadia meeting to Monday, August 13, 2012. The motion carried by a voice vote.
