Town of Arcadia Minutes of Regular Board Meeting Monday, August 27, 2012 at 7 p.m.

The August 27, 2012 board meeting was called to order by Chairman Ronald Tuschner at 7:00 p.m. Open meeting certifications were met. Roll call was taken. All Board members were present: Chairman Ronald Tuschner and Supervisors Michael Wineski and Ivan Pronschinske. Also present were the attached list of residents.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to adopt the agenda as prepared. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the July 30, 2012 meeting minutes. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve the August 13, 2012 and August 15, 2012 Board of Review meeting minutes. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve disbursements of August 26, 2012 voucher #17169 through voucher #17186. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

At 7:03 p.m. R. Tuschner opened the floor to public comments for other topics that were not listed on the August 27, 2012 agenda. Jim Palahniuk commented regarding signage for mine sites. Ivan Pronschinske will have a sign added to Soppa Rd. on private property. R. Tuschner made a second call for requests for comments. R. Tuschner made a third call for requests for comments. No further public comments were made. At 7:05 p.m. R. Tuschner closed the floor to public comments.

Annexation request to the City of Arcadia by Jason and Nikki Michalak

First presentation of Pronschinske non-metallic sand mine by KAW Valley.

Ivan Pronschinske addressed the Board that he would again abstain from any comments or actions on this matter as this topic pertains personally to him.

The mine site will now include an additional 133 acres of Gerrad and Wina Sonsalla property. There will be two owners, Mr. Pronschinske as well as Sonsalla's for a total of 158 acres. Proposed sand mine will now be referred to as the KAW Valley mine site. More information to follow at subsequent meetings.

Thompson Valley Road

R. Tuschner updated the Board in regards to Thompson Valley Road. Many parties have been contacted regarding this issue. It could be a number of weeks before something is done in regards to help from the DNR. There will be a "road use agreement" between the Arcadia Sand Company and the Town of Arcadia, whereas the contract will be specific to both parties. This document is required by the Land Conservation Department and will be reviewed periodically. Time is needed by the Arcadia Sand Company to review said document. R. Tuschner has extending the review to 2 weeks. This item will be added to the next meeting's agenda for further discussion.

D. Rossa voiced a concern on funds received from mines for road maintenance. After mine is closed it will be the Board's discretion regarding allocation of funds.

Gold'n Plump request regarding for use of roadway

A representative from Gold'n Plump requested an allowance to go up to 90,000 lbs. using another axle. R. Tuschner contacted Ayres and Associates. They will inspect each bridge in the Township at a cost of \$500 a bridge. Pictures will be taken as well as analyzing and reanalyzing prior to a written approval. The township has over 40 bridges, will be very significant cost. Discussion occurred. Will continue to be discussed in future meetings.

Arcadia Ambulance Service Budget

Discussion ensued regarding the budget for the ambulance service. The cost per capita will be \$9.82 per resident; 1790 residents in the Township for a total expenditure of \$17,577.80. A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the budget as presented. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Arcadia Ambulance Service contract with other municipalities

As of December 31, 2012 the Mayo Clinic will not be associated with the Arcadia Ambulance Service any longer. Pronschinske indicated that the only change will be the name change of Mayo to Tri-County Memorial Hospital. A 3 year contract will be signed by all other municipalities.

Korpall Valley Road Update

On Wed, Aug, 30th, a new culvert will be added, ditch will be cleaned out and back fill will be added.

2012 Bridge Petitions

The following petitions will be turned in for reimbursement Trempealeau County Highway dept.: Kamrowski Lane for \$1208.96 and KGB Lane for \$12938.84. A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve the petition as presented. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Operator's License for Marcus Steinmetz

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve the operator's license request. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Fall Clean Up Day

The Township Fall Clean-Up Day date was set for Saturday, September 29, 8 AM until Noon. A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to approve the date as presented. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Town of Arcadia Foreman projects update

Boberg Lane – Ditch not done due to gas line issue. Dennis Service indicated that the gas line is possibly down the center of the road. According to Foreman the gas line was moved alongside the road. R. Tuschner to check into.

Amundson Lane project has been completed.

Municipal phone plan from US Cellular will cost \$40 a month. Foreman indicated that Township should pay this expense. More discussion to follow by board members.

The Sander that was tipped in 2009 is twisted and chain is bad. Universal will not repair. It is possible for it to be repaired by D. Lyga. Agreed to take truck to Whitehall for repair.

Foreman will be gone for 2 weeks starting October 2nd. Part-time help will be needed.

Correspondence

Increase in rates for insurance of 3.7%.

R. Tuschner discussed the potential of additional housing costs regarding the comprehensive plan.

Agenda items were discussed

A motion was made by R. Tuschner and seconded by M. Wineski to set the next regular Town of Arcadia meeting to Monday, September 10, 2012 at 5 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.

Part-time help applications will be reviewed at the next board meeting during a closed session.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
