Town of Arcadia Minutes of Regular Board Meeting September 10 at 5 p.m.

The September 10, 2012 board meeting was called to order by Chairman Ronald Tuschner at 5:00 p.m. Open meeting certifications were met. Roll call was taken. All Board members were present: Chairman Ronald Tuschner and Supervisors Michael Wineski and Ivan Pronschinske. Also present were the attached list of residents.

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to adopt the agenda as prepared. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve the August 27, 2012 meeting minutes. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

A motion made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve disbursements of September 10, 2012 voucher #17201 through voucher #17219. The motion was carried with a voice vote.

At 5:05 p.m. R. Tuschner opened the floor to public comments for other topics that were not listed on the September 10, 2012 agenda. R. Tuschner made the first call for requests for comments. Jeff Bawek responded by asking if a public comment session could also be held at the end of the meeting. The Board will take it under advisement. R. Tuschner made a second call and third call for requests for comments. At 5:08 p.m. R. Tuschner closed the floor to public comments.

Arcadia Sand Company road maintenance and upgrade contract

D. Sokup asked to move discussion to a later meeting. They will contact Board when ready to present.

Formal Presentation of KAW Valley Mine Site

The mine will consist of only the removal of sand, in 15 phases. KAW Valley will build storm water ponds to withstand 100 yr. storm. Discussed right of ways, truck traffic, timing of phases. Trempealeau County has already received a tentative plan from KAW Valley. Questions were raised by J. Bawek regarding mine site: bluff will remain by Cty. N, the retention pond will be behind the bluff and there will be a berm around the site. The Conditional Uses will be discussed during the next board meeting.

Soppa Road Surface

The intersection improvement paperwork is now underway with plans to reconstruct Soppa Road. The TPS company will be required to send a road use agreement to the Town Board, with a reminder that all legal fees will need to be paid by TPS.

Arcadia/Glencoe Fire Department Budget

The Arcadia/Glencoe Fire Board requested an increase of \$20,000 to the 2013 budget. At this time the board feels that it cannot support that. A motion was made by M. Wineski to not accept the budget as proposed, and was seconded by I. Pronschinske.

Application from WI Horsepullers for Temporary Class "B" retailers license

Form received from R. Soppa for approval of a class "B" license. A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to approve. Motion carried by voice vote.

Snow Removal Rates for 2012/2013 season

The Town Board discussed rates for the upcoming snow removal season. A motion was made by R. Tuschner and seconded by M. Wineski to keep rates the same as last year. Motion carried by voice vote.

Road names – North Creek and River Valley Roads

Fritz Conrad discussed the possibility of renaming a section of road by River Valley as it is very confusing (road sign indicates both directions). Ron Tuschner made a motion to rename the road to Walske Road. Motion was seconded by M. Wineski, and was carried with a voice vote. Signage will be added and reviewed by road crew.

Town of Arcadia personnel US Cellular Plan

F. Conrad presented findings to the Town Board regarding cell phone rates from US Cellular. During the last meeting he stated that since there is so much usage on his personal phone for Town issues he would like the Town to help pay for this service. During discussion an agreement was made that if a person would leave the Township position the plan would cease. A motion was made by I. Pronschinske to pay for half, and was seconded by M. Wineski. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Closed session

The Town Board went into a closed session regarding applications for part time help.

Open session

The meeting reopened to the public at 6:25 PM after I. Pronschinske made a motion. It was seconded by M. Wineski and carried by a voice vote.

A motion was made by M. Wineski and seconded by I. Pronschinske to hire three individuals as part-time help for the Town road crew (Tanner Kidd, Jon Olson II, and Mark Engvold). The motion carried by a voice vote.

Correspondence

The Town Board received a new bid for KGB Lane. Will be a 3 to 4 week waiting period to get underway with repairs.

The Town also received an application from the DNR in regards to the Thompson Valley Road project. It was agreed that more expertise is needed to understand ramifications of project, possibly look into hiring an engineer.

Agenda Items were discussed

A motion was made by I. Pronschinske and seconded by M. Wineski to set the next regular Town of Arcadia meeting to Monday, September 24, 2012 at 7 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.
