

NOTES FROM COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MEETING

August 12, 2013

Meeting was called to order by R. Tuschner at 7:05 pm. All Board Members were present. Other committee members present were: Ellen Czapski, Ed Patzner, and Beth Killian. Also in attendance was Peter Fletcher.

Peter Fletcher gave a brief history of the sand mining district in the Town of Caledonia which included a map and part of their comprehensive plan. The Town of Caledonia was concerned with keeping mining out of the drinking water, creating a bowl in which pesticides and nitrates would collect, and having no row cropping in the reclaimed areas.

Challenges for the Town of Arcadia comprehensive plan:

1. Where would the mining overlay district be?
2. What would be the criteria?
3. Define the industrial scale.
4. Creating a total number of acreage for mines.
