Town of Arcadia Minutes of Regular Town Board Meeting Thursday, March 9th, 2017 at 5:15 p.m.

The board meeting was called to order by Chairperson Jon Schultz at 5:24 p.m. Open meeting certifications were met. Roll call was taken. Board members present: Jon Schultz, Barb Tock and Donna Brogan. A list of residents that attended is available at the Town Hall.

Jon Schultz led the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Donna Brogan and seconded by Jon Schultz to adopt the agenda. The motion carried unanimously with a voice vote.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

At 5:27 p.m. Chairman Schultz opened the floor to public comments for other topics that were not listed on the March 9th, 2017 agenda.

****Jon Olson** – he stated that accounts of earlier meetings indicated that there were problems with the Peterbuilt truck. It should have been No. 10, “Little Red” International instead. Olson continued by letting the group know that the truck was in Eau Claire for repair, and that costs are covered by the warranty. He commented that there are no issues with anything that was completed at Universal...all problems revolve around International.

After the third call by Chairperson Schultz the Public Comment section closed at 5:29 p.m.

AGENDA ITEMS:

- **Review of a five-year road plan, including discussion regarding 2017 projects:** Donna Brogan led the discussion. She provided 3 different handouts that spoke to 3 categories of Town roads: Co-aid, non co-aid and lanes. All roads that were listed were previously rated. Brogan stated that there is approximately \$730,000 in the fund. The worst rated Co-Aid roads were Lewis Valley and North Creek. Discussion turned to how some roads need to be re-rated due to repairs last year. The group

discussed what road to focus on, and then how much could be completed within the next year. A question was posed as to what the Co-Aid funds pay for. Brogan responded that pulverizing, paving, gravel for shoulders, and culverts are included. John Kampa's thoughts were that the highly traveled roads should be reviewed first. He asked the Board what they felt should be completed (i.e. blade patching, seal coating, etc.). Barb Tock was concerned that seal-coating wouldn't last on roads that have been patched numerous times. Kampa stated that full reconstruction could be very costly. Discussion continued. Jon Schultz asked if road preparation (replacing culverts, etc) was completed last season for Lewis Valley and North Creek; Olson confirmed. Other concerns that were voiced were dealing with the DNR regarding bridge replacements. Brogan commented that she wanted to ensure there were funds left for other roads as well. Discussion then turned to other township's projects and how the Town crew could possibly work with them on certain roads. Schultz stated that this meeting should focus on prioritizing. The township road information Brogan provided was reviewed by category, as well as what type of repairs should be completed. At the conclusion of the discussion, Brogan stated that she will have a road project plan in place by the annual meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
